We are excited to announce that our *Licking Summer Camps* will enter its 17th year this summer with **18 camps**, ten in basketball and 8 in volleyball, to be held in 7 locations throughout Missouri and Illinois. *Last year's program attracted over 16,000 athletes from 888 schools from a seven state area. The camps are exclusively for junior high and high school girl's school affiliated teams.*

We will once again use the **Rolla, MO** area as home base. We will in the Summer of 2010, host 8 camps in Rolla. The area's central location, easy highway access, numerous motels and restaurants, and overall friendliness; has created what many past campers have fondly referred to over the years as "the Rolla Experience." Don't forget the area's numerous fine floating streams. Many teams stay over an extra day to make a relaxing float the "icing on the cake" for their summer camp adventure. **We can make your floating arrangements for you at the lowest price on the river.** In Rolla, we will once again utilize the outstanding facilities at the Missouri University of Science and Technology, the Rolla Public Schools, the St. James Public Schools and the "awesome" courts at the Rolla Centre. The Splash Zone Water Park will again be available for our always popular **Friday Night Swim**.

In 2009, we began a pilot program we named: **Legends of the Game Clinics**. Hall of Fame **Coach Cheryl Burnett**, and her most decorated pupil, two time All-American **Jackie Stiles**, conducted two **free player/coaches clinics** for us. The attendance and evaluation of the clinics was very positive. This year, we hope to expand the program to include as many weekends as we can. Once again, this will be a free event and another reason to choose Licking Summer Camps for all of your summer plans. More details will be forthcoming shortly.

A new camp location this year will be **Jacksonville, IL**. We will host a basketball camp on June 11-12 at MacMurray College. The Highlander's head women's coach, **Annie Ewing**, will be the camp director. Coach Ewing is the daughter of long time successful St. Louis area girl's high school coach, and current head coach at St. Louis Lutheran South High School, Jim Ewing. Annie is entering her second season at the helm of the MacMurray program and will, we have no doubt, run a very good camp for us.

For the fifth consecutive year we will host a basketball camp at Fox High School in **Arnold, MO**. Arnold is located at the southern edge of the St. Louis metropolitan area, adjacent to Interstate 55. All the facilities that we utilize are within easy driving distance and all gyms are air conditioned. The venues will once again be Fox High School and Middle School, Seckman High School and Middle School; along with state of the art facilities at the Arnold Community Center and the Arnold First Baptist Church. Camp Director will be **Joe Salsman**, Athletic Director of Fox High School.

We are expanding our **Branson, MO** offerings. We will add a basketball camp to our Branson schedule this summer. Branson Parks and Recreation Director **Cindy Shook** will be our BB camp director. We are in the process of making arrangements to have a heavy involvement of Former Missouri State Lady Bears for this camp. We will release details soon, but it should add excitement to our inaugural Branson basketball camp. Our volleyball camp will once again be under the capable direction of **Jeff Wead**, head coach of the Branson Pirates. Our volleyball camp in 2009 grew to over 100 teams, and it is easy to see why. For many obvious reasons, the Branson Area is a great venue for a summer camp. The Branson/Lakes Area has over 18,000 lodging units ranging from four star resorts where gourmet breakfast is served to guests as they watch the sun rise over Table Rock Lake, to establishments on world famous Hwy. 76 complete with swimming pools, water parks, miniature golf courses and family-style restaurants.

Bismark High School will serve as the host site of our *Farmington, MO* volleyball camp. Farmington is located on the US Highway 67 corridor, an easy one hour drive from the St. Louis area. Much like Rolla, the Farmington area offers numerous and adequate motel and eating establishments, along with the safety and friendliness of small town hospitality. Facilities for this camp are outstanding. Our visiting athletes will compete at the brand new Bismark High School courts, the gyms of the Farmington and Park Hills Public schools and the Field House located on the campus of Mineral Area Community College. This area is a hot bed for high school volleyball and has proved to be one of our most competitive camps. The camp director for the fourth year will be long time successful Bismark Coach, **Paula AuBuchon**.

We will for the second year host a volleyball camp in **Quincy, IL**. The Blue Devils of Quincy High, under the leadership of head coach **Barb Crist**, have become a dominant force in Illinois volleyball, recently qualifying for the state final four in the Illinois Large School Class. Coach Crist will serve as our camp director. Quincy is a great sports town with excellent event venues and a more than adequate supply of reasonably priced restaurants and motels.

We were so pleased with the reception and evaluation by our coaches of our two camps last summer at the **St. Louis Sports Center**, that we have doubled our events there, adding both a second volleyball and basketball event to our 2010 schedule. The Sports Center is confidentially located off of Interstate 55 in the South St. Louis Metro area.
