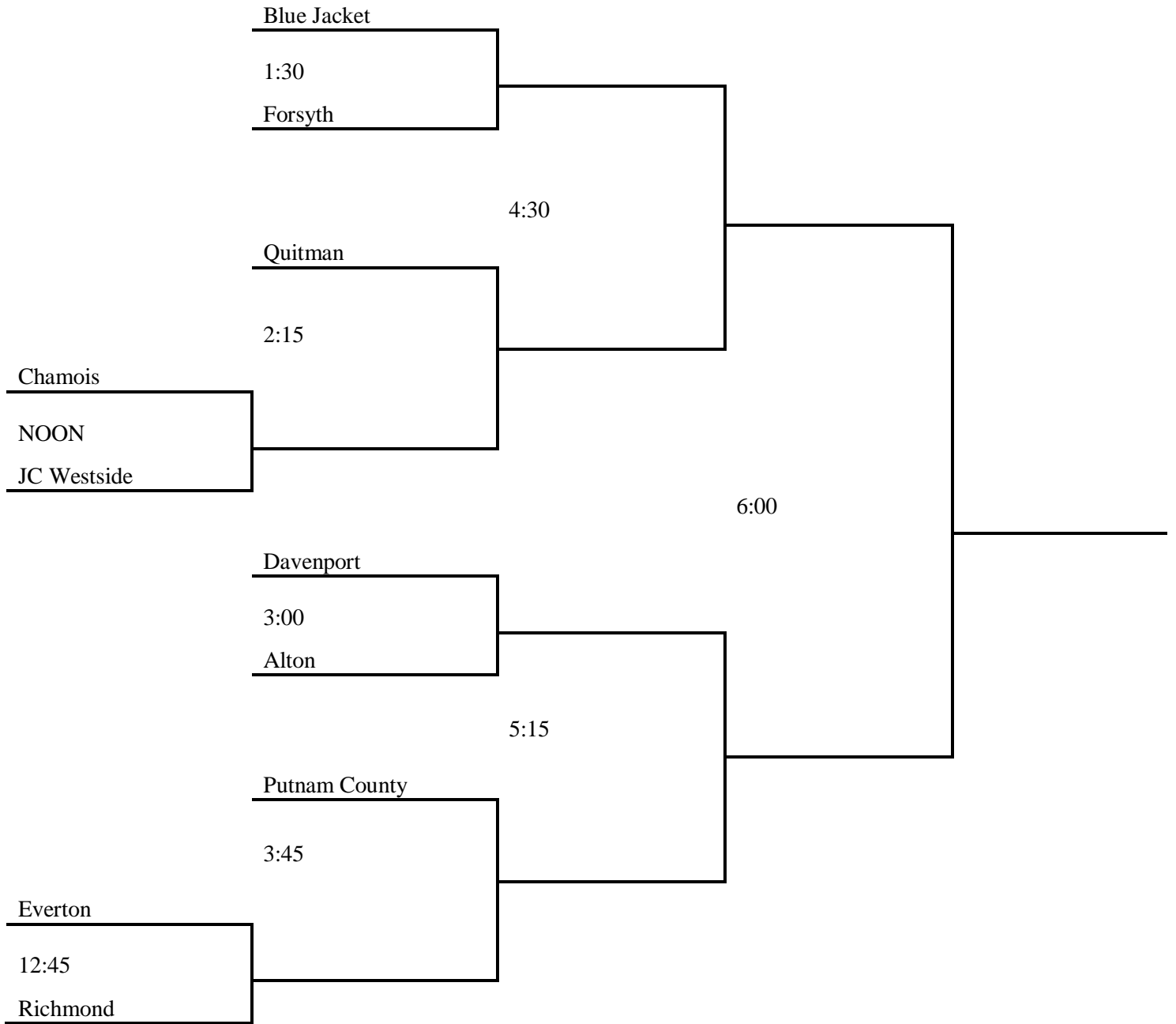

Alton..... Coach Norm Hollis..... Enrollment 330.....The Comets anticipate a rebuilding year in 2012 as all five starters from last year's 8-15 club have graduated.....Former boys long time coach, Hollis will start his year with the girls program at the Big Springs Conference member.....Long time camp entry.

BlueJacket, OK.....Coach Michael Germany Schnatz.....Enrollment 200.....First year in camp for the Sooner State school..... Return an experienced team that made it to the area finals in 2011..... Graduate only one starter..... Defending NEO Tournament champions and District titlist.....Look to challenge for a birth at state in 2012.....Good first year entry to our camp lineup.

Bowling Green..... Coach Bobby Spoonster..... Enrollment 350..... 20-6 season ended with a semifinal loss to South Shelby in a loaded district tournament..... Strong classes have graduated the last two seasons, but good young talent ready to meet the challenge of continuing winning tradition.....Bobcats are members of the EMO Conference.....Long time camp entry.

Centralia.....Coach Mike Hann..... Enrollment 420..... The Panthers will be experienced this winter as seven players return who started at least one game during the 2011 12-14 campaign.....Finished third in the Clarence Cannon Conference and second in the District Tournament.....Goal is to top the .500 mark.....Long time camp entry.

Chamois..... Coach Marty Gerloff..... Enrollment 100..... The Pirates will enter the 2012 season with a new head coach, but hope to continue winning ways..... Return three regulars, including a junior who was the Show Me Conference Player of the Year as a sophomore..... Won 16 games in 2011, highlighted by titles of the Jamestown and Tipton Tournaments..... Finished second in the district....Long time camp entry.

Charleston, AR.....Coach Jason Rucker..... Enrollment 350..... First year in camp for the Tigers.....Strong class 3A team as all five starters return from last year's 25-9 team.....Won conference and district titles..... Qualified for state tournament..... Expect to compete for a state title this year.....Very good first year addition to our camp lineup.

Davenport, OK..... Coach Danny Accord.....Enrollment 102..... First year in camp for the Bulldogs..... Small school who has seen an upswing in programs fortunes topped off last year with the schools best post season finish, winning a district title..... Member of the Cimarron Valley Conference..... Return three starters from a 20-9 team.

Dixon..... Coach Craig Moody..... Enrollment 300..... The Bulldogs are poised for a big year in 2012..... Return all five starters for Coach Moody's second year at the helm of the Frisco League school..... Finished 2011 with a 15-9 mark.....Hope to challenge for conference and district titles and fight deep into state play.....Long time camp entry.

East Newton..... Coach Rinhart..... Enrollment 495..... The Patriots will return a veteran bunch from last season's 11-14 club..... Return all five starters from a team that rebounded nicely from a 1-9 season start.....Knocked off Clever in the first round of the district tournament.....Long time camp entry.

Everton..... Coach Kim Gladden..... Enrollment 65..... The small enrollment Tigers have always overcome their small pool of perspective players to field very competitive teams.....Look for another solid crew from the Mark Twain Conference member in 2012 as three starters return from a 17-10 team.....Seven of 10 losses were to state powers Dadeville and Chadwick..... Lost to Dadeville in District finals.....Have several incoming freshman who should give immediate help to the varsity.....Long time camp entry.

Forsyth..... Coach Jim Voliva..... Enrollment 360..... The Panthers intend to move above the .500 mark this upcoming season as four regulars return from last year's 9-14 team..... Also look to improve on their 2011 2-5 finish in the SWCL Conference..... Took 4<sup>th</sup> in the Blue Eye and Reed Springs Tournaments.

Johnson County Westside, AR..... Coach Steve Golden.....Enrollment 150.....Second year in camp for the Rebels..... Return three starters from a team that finished 2011 at 3-24.....Have strong sophomore class ready to step into varsity action and hope infusion will lead to more success this winter.

Putnam County..... Coach Craig DeVore..... Enrollment 210..... Return all five starters from last year's 11-14 club..... The Midgets expect to be much improved in 2012 as hope is experience has taught team to close out close games..... Lost a double overtime thriller to Milan in District Tournament....Member of the Tri-County Conference.

Quitman, AR..... Coach Lou Ann Sanders..... Enrollment 150..... First year in camp for the Bulldogs....Return entire roster from 2011 16-10 team..... Look to improve on runner up finishes in conference, district and regional play..... The northern Arkansas club is a good first year addition to our camp lineup.

Richmond..... Coach Dave Littrell..... Enrollment 511.....the Spartans return a good nucleus, but must replace a solid point guard lost to graduation off of last year's 12-13 club.....Non-Conference will be upgraded next season, so returnees must respond.....Depth is an off season concern.....Member of the Missouri River Conference.....Long time camp entry.

Sullivan..... Coach Jason Merkel..... Enrollment 800.....The Eagles produced another strong contingent last winter, finishing with a 17-8 record.....Compete in the Four Rivers Conference with powers Hermann, New Haven and St. James, amongst others..... Return four starters.....Also expect the JV to be solid, so no down years in the near horizon for this long time camp entry.

The Trojans look to regain the form that led to a state title three years ago.....Return four regulars, including an all-state performer who averaged 23 pts and 13 boards a game in 2011..... Finished the year at 14-12..... Will welcome an outstanding group of incoming freshman.....Members of the Southwest Central League.

Todd County, KY..... Coach Steve Phillips..... Enrollment 560..... New addition to our camp lineup will be our first from Kentucky in several seasons..... The Rebels return three starters from a 10-11 team in 2011..... Play in Region 4 of the Kentucky state alignment..... If injuries can be avoided, expect the 2012 season to be a good one.
